[PERFORMANCE CATEGORIES]

- Classical
- Neoclassical
- Modern/Contemporary
- Pas de Deux
- Group Dance

※Classical and Modern/Contemporary solo performances must not exceed 3 minutes.

※Participants entering two performances may not perform the same piece twice.

[DIVISIONS]

- Primary (9–12 years)
- Secondary (13–15 years)
- Junior (16–18 years)
- Senior (19–25 years)
- Professional Session (18+)

※Age as of the competition date.

[Professional Session Entry Requirements]

- Aged 18 or over
- Currently working professionally in ballet or pursuing a professional career in ballet

Eligible applicants include ballet company members, apprentices, ballet school students, junior ballet company members, ballet teachers, studio directors and teaching assistants.

※Participants aged 18–25 may enter both the Professional Session and the applicable Junior or Senior division according to their age. However, the same piece may not be performed in both divisions.

One Pas de Deux: €180

Group Dance: €90 per participant

Professional Session: €100

[PRIZES]

Professional Session Gold Medal: €1,200

Munich Grand Prix Award: €1,000

Best Artistic Performance Award: €300

International Ballet Forum Award: €200

※Awards may not be presented if no participant meets the required standard.

[MUSIC]

Please prepare two CDs: one for the performance and one as a backup.

Each CD must be clearly labelled with the participant's name and division.

※Classical ballet works or music protected by copyright may not be entered. This includes works such as "Tchaikovsky Pas de Deux" and "Sylvia," as well as Balanchine works and revised versions created by contemporary choreographers.

※For the Modern/Contemporary category, participants must obtain any necessary permission for the use of music and choreography.

※Participants are responsible for handling and paying any applicable copyright fees. If copyright fees are charged to the organizer, the participant will be invoiced at a later date.
